Today's verse says to pray continually. As frequently as, say, breathing. That means praying as you brush your teeth. Praying before, during, and after a test. Praying for your teammates—and the other team—as you're playing soccer. Praying out loud and in public. Praying silently and in private. It means talking to God without stopping because you want to know Him better.



Set an alarm to chime each hour to remind you to stop for a moment of prayer.



ASK God to help you develop good, life-long prayer habits.
