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KNOW that God loves a cheerful giver.

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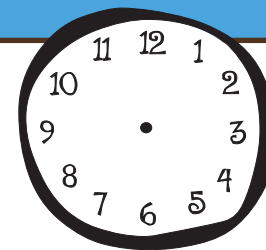
Day 3
