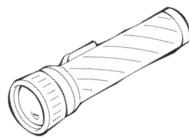
Day 1

Read 2 Corinthians 4:7

To “shine” like Jesus, you act like Him. But that’s not something you can do all on your own. God gives you power to be kind and forgiving like Jesus. Then, the more you follow Jesus, the more God helps you become like Him. When you do this, other people will see Jesus’ “light shining in you.”

Take the battery out of a flashlight and turn it on. Does it shine? You need Jesus in order to shine for Him, just like a flashlight needs its battery. Think about that every time you see a flashlight.

Read Matthew 9:36; 14:14; 15:32 and 20:34

Look at what all these verses have in common. Again and again we read that Jesus had compassion for people. He cared about their needs and hurts and responded by helping them. Read Colossians 3:13
