Read Matthew 5:8

Pure water doesn't have sand, dirt, or gunk in it. A pure heart doesn't have wrong motives in it. A motive is the reason you do something. The right motive to serve others is to PLEASE GOD, so don't serve for the wrong reasons, like getting praised or noticed by people.



Be a Secret Servant

Do acts of service around the house (*empty dishwasher, take out trash, make beds*) without letting anyone see or know you did it. See how long you can get away with it.

Read 1 Peter 5:5b

Week 1 04

Today's verse tells us not to help people so others will think we're a "big deal." God is on the side of people who serve quietly, without drawing attention. A humble servant (one who's modest, showing respect for others) understands that God alone is the "Big Deal." So he or she serves in order to shine the spotlight on God.

Use a **pencil** to poke holes in a piece of **paper** as shown below. Tape the paper over the lens cover on a **flashlight**. Turn it on to see God's name shine. (If God's name is backwards, just turn it over and re-tape it on the flashlight.)

Read Colossians 3:13

Your dad asks you to help your sister clean her room, but yesterday she wrecked your favorite toy. Serving her is the last thing you want to do! Holding a grudge can wreck your desire to serve. To serve God completely, you need to make a habit of forgiving others, the same way God forgives you.

Pick up a small **rock** for each grudge you are holding. Forgive each person as you "toss" those grudges and **drop** the rocks on the **ground**.
